

Lab on Loops CPS 171 J. Remen

This lab is to give you practice using different kinds of loops. It should be done along with the exercise on loops discussed in class.

Start a Visual Studio session with an empty project.

Look at <http://www.hal9k.com/cps171/LabLoops.html> in your browser.

The file contains the basic outline of a program, which you will modify. **The program has missing parts for you to fill in – it does not compile at present.** It is based on the worksheet on looping that was done in class.

You will see that questions 1 - 4 from the worksheet are in their own sections of code with comments around each one. This is so that you can work on one at a time by removing the /* and */ around that particular question, run the program to see that it works, and then go on to the next one.

If you complete questions 1 - 4, then try writing the code for questions 5, 6 and 7. These will involve making up some data files of your own.

Hand in a listing of the program with as many of the questions done as you had time to complete, and the output.
